# Announcement of Full-Time Position Faculty of Education, Institute of Human and Social Sciences Kanazawa University (Female-Only Recruitment)

 Number of positions: One Professor (tenured), Associate Professor (tenured), or Lecturer (five-year fixed-term contract\*)

\*The term of lecturer is set for 5 years at the time of employment. (If you are currently working at our university and work continuously, the total term of office, from the current term to the next term, cannot exceed 10 years.) The candidate will be converted to adequate tenured status, based on the following achievements, which is to be implemented during the term.

- (1) Educational achievements (Lecture, Practicum, Seminar, Research guidance, etc.)
- (2) Research achievements (Research papers, Presentations at conferences, Research grants)
- (3) Contribution to the university and society, and so on

#### 4. Subjects to Teach:

- (1) School Courses: Development and Education (Development as Self-Creation), Young Children and Human Relationships (Social Development and Contemporary Issues), Methods of Teaching Childcare Content (Human Relationships), Methods of Teaching Human Relationships, Developmental Psychology I/II, Young Children and Health, Special Lecture on Child Psychology I/II, Seminar in Child Psychology I/II, Teaching Practicum, Research Project
- (2) Teaching Courses in the College of Human and Social Sciences, Science and Engineering, and Undergraduate Training Course for School Nurses: Psychology of Development and Learning A/B

- (3) Courses for the Certified Public Psychologist Training Program: Developmental Psychology I/II (offered jointly with the School of Teacher Education)
- (4) Master's Program in the Graduate School: Lectures and seminars related to the Division of Regional Development Studies
  - \* As a general rule, the university operates on a quarter system, with all courses spanning eight weeks and carrying one credit.
  - \* A common subject for the school of teacher education may be required to teach.
  - \* Since our school is operating the Joint Institute of Teacher Education with department of education in University of Toyama, students from University of Toyama may attend the classes above. The classes are provided online.
  - \* The classes above may be required to teach in English.

#### 5. Qualifications:

- Applicants must meet all of the following conditions (1) through (5). Condition (6) is desirable but not mandatory:
- (1) Holding a doctoral degree (a doctoral degree having been awarded by April 2026 at the latest) or the qualifications equivalent to PhD
- (2) An applicant's nationality does not affect the selection. However, the candidate must be able to conduct classes, advise students, complete administrative tasks, contribute to committee works, and perform other necessary work in Japanese.
- (3) Residence in Kanazawa or surrounding cities after employment.
- (4) Being passionate about teacher education and having a strong devotion to education and the community.
- (5) A proven track record of obtaining scientific research grants, academic research funding, and other public research funds.
- (6) Applicants must hold a teaching license for kindergarten, elementary school, junior high school, high school, or special-needs school and possess teaching experience (including part-time teaching) at one of these levels.

Note. In accordance with Article 8 of the **Equal Employment Opportunity Law** (special provisions regarding measures for female workers), this open recruitment is limited to female applicants as a transitional measure to proactively address the significant underrepresentation of female faculty members.

- (4) A Summary of the research achievements (approximately 1000 characters in Japanese or 600 words in English)
- (5) Statement on the applicant's prospective research and education at School of Teacher Education (approximately 1000 characters in Japanese or 600 words in English)
  - \* Please use the university format below in preparing your resume and list of achievements.

#### 9. Selection process:

After the document-based selection, short-listed candidates will be called for an interview and be asked to give a teaching demonstration. Travel costs (including overseas travel) for the interview are not covered by the university.
